Originally should have been an 18-hole competition, it was reduced to 10 holes as heavy rain was expected. This proved to be a sound decision and most players avoiding the deteriorating conditions

Adapting to the Times

During December the Lady Captain and I met with the Men's Captain and Competition Secretary to discuss how we as a Club should be more integrated. We primarily discussed Sunday golf. The requirement is to provide more flexibility as to when individuals play, to not be restricted to when on a Sunday they play and with whom they play.

The first step to move this forward is to align the type of competitions that are played on a Sunday i.e. when the Men are playing their monthly Medal or Stableford so do the Ladies. Also, ensure the monthly Ladies competitions do not clash with the 'OPEN to ALL Members' competitions. The first stage of this, March thru to July has been submitted for discussion.

There is a potential problem with how the finances will work discussions are ongoing.
