- 1. County Competitions. Unfortunately, both the Parks and Beaumont teams failed to progress from their semi-finals v Felixstowe and Bramford. It is a great achievement to be reaching the semi-finals of these competitions again, especially with it being the Parks teams third year in a row. In particular, I'd like to thank Ian Stannard on behalf of the club for his excellent captaincy of the Parks team. Stan has decided it's time to step back and let someone else manage the great squad he has assembled.
 - ** Having successfully persuaded Suffolk Golf Union to hold 'public' draws for the competitions I am now engaged with them regarding moving to neutral venues for all matches, which the Ladies section manage to do in their county competitions.
- 2. Club Committee meeting minutes circulated. Agenda will evolve but a good start with a focus on looking forward as a club and creating more time for planning diaries & events.
- 3. Gents Club Championship a very successful event played over a long hot weekend. It was great to see the top three all coming down the last fairway together as the last group out. Congratulations to Danny Milne for finally getting it over the line and becoming worthy club champion. Brad Reynolds was a very popular nett winner but pushed Danny all the way for the main prize. The everpresent Paul Coby was unable to pull back the five shot gap Danny created on Saturday and was last seen cursing his putter! However, it is worth noting that Paul is a record 'seven time' club Champion and it's a fantastic achievement to keep challenging year on year. Well done all that entered.

4. Junior's section -

- Juniors Championship 14 juniors entered with George Swallow (0) scoring a gross 76 to win this year's title. George has now equalled Ali Hall & Archie Winters club record of four junior championship wins. He has one more year to break that record. Harry Hinsley (23) became the nett champion with a score of nett 70. Both were presented with their trophies after the club championship where a larger audience could applaud and recognise their achievements.
- **Juniors Open –** 38 competed in the Junior Open this year. Josie Knights (lpswich) playing off scratch won with a gross 76.
- **Junior Members** Currently we have 37 Juniors with handicaps & 59 without (96 in total)

9) **Treasurer's Report** – new format spreadsheet.

Discussion about the accuracy of some of the figures on the initial spreadsheet. It was agreed not to include in the minutes until we are satisfied that the figures reflect the accounts fully. Recognition this is a new method of reporting. We do wish to share monthly finance report with members for transparency. Action - KPB to review and provide accurate figures for next month's report

- Ken talked through the spreadsheet
- Request to separate the Juniors fundraising money from Lois's coaching fund. Action KPB to change format
- Surplus looks like £2,400. KPB will review this figure as he feels it is inflated.
- GJ highlighted small error on RS sheet Action Point GJ to speak to RS

Competition Money

- 1. From Rob's figures there were 31 competitions on a Sunday with an average of 75.4 entrants. To estimate this as an annual number of competition entrants, assume there are 44 competitions (this allows for weather disruption in a typical year) and therefore 3,300 competition entries.
- 2. From my spreadsheet you will see a figure 'Total cash 'out' at £3,760. This is found from the competition entries.
- 3. If the number of entries is steady but that there is mild inflation (5%) in expenditure, there needs to be a charge of £1.25 on each competition entry.
- 4. The 2-ball money is not included in this it should be self-balancing, maybe not quite each week but in general.
- 5. Therefore, there is a minimum of £1.75 per entrant per competition required.

 Anything in excess of this can be used for prize money IF nothing else changes.
- 6. Earlier this year members were asked if there were any matters on which they would like to see money expended. The result was that all bar one item suggested would be matters for the Management to deal with rather than the members.
- 7. However, with the acquisition of Mells Court Farm by the owners, there will no doubt be changes in arrangements. Ben may make some comments about this in the

- Meeting. These changes may cause there to be matters that might need funding by the members to be addressed.
- 8. If the competition entry fee is set at £3.50, there would be available for a typical competition a prize pot of £131 (not including 2s money).
- 9. If the entry fee is set at £5.00, this becomes £244.
- 10. The distribution of the prize pot in the figures presented by Rob shows the winners receiving £44, with division winners £88 a total of £132. The total payout averages £230 for next placed etc.
- 11. Note therefore that the level of prizes is set by the level of entry fee, or the converse the entry fee is set by the level of prize expectation.
- 12. (The subsidy of £1500 to remove an excess of monies is not relevant to the future).

Halesworth Golf Club – Handicap Report 20th August 2025

Penalty Scores -

There have been no penalty scores added since the last meeting. Still errors when starting rounds on IG in conjunction with entering a competition. Explaining to each player how to add scores.

Juniors/New Members

Since Alistair left and Richard is on leave, I've received several Junior cards for handicaps. I have emailed Jeremy Jenkins regarding this but wanted to pass this onto the committee.

There were a large majority of cards that were inadmissible for handicaps due to various issues.

No date, not signed, not enough holes scored and held back for too long were a few I can mention.

Ensuring Juniors and new members know how to complete cards correctly will be beneficial. I have offered Jeremy my services to speak to the Juniors.

Soft Cap/Hard Cap

Currently 24 players with 'Soft cap' enabled. Two players with 'Hard cap' enabled. Player 1 has not added any scores from September 2023 until April 2025. Clearly had a break from golf and now returning higher scores. Will continue to monitor their scores being added to see if they need any further upward adjustment now that the hard cap is in effect.

Player 2 has regular scores being added included competition rounds. The majority of their counting rounds are general play scores so this would indicate no intentional manipulation.

No cause for concern and will continue to monitor.

We have had 12 members drop off the soft cap list in the last two months.

There are 12 new additions to the 'soft cap' list. All those members have been looked at and all have played a large majority of competition rounds for score submissions. No cause for concern.

Competition vs General Play

The Comp vs General Play statistics show up any irregularities between a member's scores as above and the comparison between them. This will now be checked monthly, looking back at the previous 3 months. The handicap committee will discuss any members who show up in this list and may need action depending on findings from further checking of their scores and handicap.

No members on this list meet the criteria set by the Handicap committee to require any further action.

We are now producing the above Competition vs General Play report but reproducing it in 'ascending' order of shot differences. This can then be used to identify members whose scores have caused their handicap to go up but may still be struggling to play anywhere near to their current handicap. This will then be discussed by the Handicap Committee at the next meeting.

Discussion took place – PK not keen to move the captain's charity Day further back in the calendar and wants to keep its historical Sunday as likely to achieve more players entries. Consensus that we don't wish to reduce potential fundraising. **Action RS to find suitable Sunday**.

12) Matters for Discussion

- Gent's competition fees –
- GJ explained to our guests why we had reduced fees this year, initially to remove the excessive surplus we had in 2024 and then more recently to reduce the build up of another surplus this year, as identified by our treasurer. The committee voted unanimously to reduce the fee and monitor reaction accordingly. KPB confirmed last year's surplus has gone.
- Concern that we have a new surplus developing but need to confirm accuracy of prediction.
- BB, PC & CH all agree no noise re fees & payments. These could confirm
 we have it right and need to increase prizemoney rather than decrease
 entry fees. Also have flexibility re county competitions.
- Seeking views should confirm that we have it right and/or allow us to tweak where necessary.
- Use of surplus long discussion re competition shirts & payments colour of tops. PK highlighted cost of competitions should we be successful across three competitions. Potential of Practice rounds (x10) of £250, meal for day (x10) £160 each round so £410 x 3 competitions (£1230 per round) so it was not an easy to either fund or plan for. With members support it becomes easier. Constitution currently doesn't allow us to carry huge surplus.
- All viewed Playing for club as an honour. However, buying new shirt each year if picked is excessive. It will be in survey
- Need to change from white shirts as do not last & look grubby it will be survey question.

- As an interim we can continue £5 entry fee but with larger prizes so as to not inflate any surplus. The work we are currently carrying out should make it easier for next year
- Chris Haslam pointed out it should not be too challenging to predict main expenses for each year (county competitions aside) nor plot our revenue stream. All agreed

Committee member nominations sheet –

PK shared the draft amended sheet. Committee discussed when & how to circulate to members to garner interest in each post. We had already voted to increase the membership to include those without specific task/roles. It was an opportunity to 'shadow' a post holder to see if it was something they would consider in the future. General consensus that ALL roles should have two people so there was effectively a backup.

Communication -

- Chris H raised the issue general communication from club. Member view is that it is poor at HG.
- Ben B & Colin H suggest club update is emailed to everyone. Club newsletter per fortnight/month. PK shared background of BT time 'away' and that he recognised communication needs to improve & is currently putting newsletter together to email to members.
- All felt Nomination sheet should be emailed to all Gents.
- Paul C raised issue that many felt the nomination sheet was a fait accompli each year and has been same for many years, likened it to a closed shop.
- Colin H shared that we had conversations this year limiting each role to three years to ensure new ideas and sharing of roles.

Gents Competition questionnaire –

- Paul K has supplied a very draft set of questions to start the debate.
- Colin H had provided an alternate framing for questions that was more adaptive version.
- RS (via email) felt it needed a more face to face approach where the background was explained to give a context. RS warned that a survey could well set the club back a few years without background & context
- GJ fed back that members were enthusiastic about being given a chance to have their opinion sought and then heard.
- As a committee we discussed each question and modified, removed or added until we had agreement of what will be sent out.

Action Paul K will circulate the new shaped list of questions to confirm accurancy before sharing with Ben T for authorisation of survey via IG.

• Timescale will be to get survey out and back in September ready for next Gents committee meeting.
